



FIRES ON ALLOTMENTS

We ask any allotment holder planning on having a fire on their plot to adhere to the following:

- Fires should only be lit when absolutely necessary and should never cause any nuisance to other plot holders, nearby residents or their properties.
 - **Avoid lighting in unsuitable weather conditions.**
 - **Avoid burning when the wind will carry the smoke over roads or into other people's property**
(Smoke hangs in the air on damp, still days and in the evening)
- Fires must be kept small and contained
- Fires must never be left unattended or left to smoulder – douse it with water if necessary.
- All bonfires must be extinguished by dusk
- Only dry, garden material should be burned.
(Never burn household rubbish, rubber or anything containing plastic, foam or paint.)
- The use of accelerants is prohibited.

Failure to adhere to these terms may result in the banning of fires across the allotment sites or termination of tenancy agreements.
